

CORRECTION NOTICE

BURBO BANK EXTENSION OFFSHORE WIND FARM ORDER 2014

SCHEDULE 4 TO THE PLANNING ACT 2008 CORRECTION OF ERRORS IN DEVELOPMENT CONSENT DECISIONS

The Secretary of State received a request dated 13 October 2014 on behalf of DONG Energy Burbo Extension (UK) Limited for the correction of errors in the Burbo Bank Extension Offshore Wind Farm Order 2014 (“the Order”), under section 119 of and Schedule 4 to, the Planning Act 2008.

The Secretary of State has made the following corrections to the Order:

Article 6 (Benefit of the Order)

The Secretary of State has amended the Order to correct the fact that, erroneously, the Order requires the Secretary of State’s consent to transfer or grant the benefit of any or all of the provisions of the Order even if the transfer or grant is to the holder of a licence under section 6 of the Electricity Act 1989. It was not intended that consent should be required in these cases and this exemption was erroneously omitted in the Order. A new sub-paragraph (7) has therefore been added which requires written notice to be given to the Secretary of State and the Marine Management Organisation before any such transfer or grant takes place and tailpieces have been added to the relevant parts of Article 6(1) (b) and 6(3) (b) which now read:

“, but paragraph (7) applies if the transferee or lessee is the holder of a licence under section 6 of the Electricity Act 1989”

Schedule 1, Part 3, (Detailed design parameters)

The Secretary of State has amended the Order to correct the fact that a heading was numbered erroneously. Paragraph 2 has therefore been removed and a new sub-heading “Detailed design parameters” inserted before paragraph 3 in Schedule 1, Part 3.
