Subject: South Humber Bank Energy Centre - request for direction under rule 13(6) of the Examination Procedure Rules 2010

Dear Liam

I am writing to request a direction to exempt the applicant from rule 13(6)(b) "post and maintain a notice of the hearing in one or more places where public notices are usually posted in the area to which the proposals contained in the application relate".

The exemption request is limited and comes after the applicant has made all reasonable efforts to comply with this requirement including travelling to the area on Friday 15 January 2021.

Due to COVID-19 the usual community noticeboards (e.g. in village halls or outdoors) in centres of population near to the site are not accessible, with the only accessible places being the window of the village store in Stallingborough (where a number of other local notices are displayed) and lamp posts in the centres of the villages.

I do not believe anyone will be prejudiced by this approach given that:

- Government rules at present are to stay at home except for essential provisions, medical care and other limited exemptions, meaning local people would not be able to access a village hall or other indoor noticeboard location.
- The shop window used sells essential provisions and will be accessed by some local people, and is where a number of other local notices are displayed, therefore is the current place where notices are posted, but it (arguably) is not where they are 'usually' posted.

We are complying with rules 13(6)(a) and (c) posting six A3 sized notices published around the edge of the site of the Proposed Development on Friday, and we will be maintaining these, along with notices in several local newspapers on 14 January 2021 (see previous e-mail). In addition the notice is published on the project website and was sent by e-mail to our project mailing list.

A map showing all notice locations is attached, along with a photograph of the shop window notice showing other notices in its windows, referred to.
