**Planning Act 2008 and The Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010**

**Application by Medworth CHP Limited (“the Applicant”) for an Order granting Development Consent for the proposed Medworth Energy from Waste Combined Heat and Power Facility (“the Medworth EfW Facility”).**

**INVITATION TO ALL IPs TO COMMENT**

1. Following the completion of the Examination on 21 August 2023, the Examining Authority submitted a Report and Recommendation in respect of its findings and conclusions on the above application to the Secretary of State on 21 November 2023. In accordance with section 107 of the Planning Act 2008, the Secretary of State has three months to determine the application.
2. On 10 January 2024, the Secretary of State issued a consultation letter to several parties seeking information on matters that were outstanding at the close of examination.
3. The Secretary of State now invites all interested parties to comment on the responses received.
