Hinkley Point C (Nuclear Generating Station) Order 2013, made 18 March 2013

Consultation on an Amendment to the Non-Material Change application in relation to the Hinkley Point C Permanent Development Site

This letter is to inform you that EDF is consulting you on a proposed amendment to the current DCO Non-Material Change application, submitted on 28 July 2020.

The Non-Material Change application proposes a number of changes to the approved plans for the purposes of changing the siting, layout and design of the buildings and structures within the Site. The application is currently with the Department for Business Energy and Industrial Strategy, who have paused their determination in order to take into account the proposed amendment set out below and any consultation responses received.

EDF now propose a minor amendment to the Parameter Plan submitted with the current Non-Material Change application, to allow for additional flexibility in the limit of deviation to locate the Back-up Emergency Equipment Store up to 15m to the south rather than the currently permitted 5m south.

The need to amend the location of the Back-up Emergency Equipment Store has arisen from the need to retain one of the temporary construction site offices further into the construction period and beyond the point at which the Back-up Emergency Equipment Store needs to be constructed, the additional flexibility means that the Back-up Emergency Equipment Store can be built alongside the temporary construction site office. Further details are provided within the attached Covering Letter.

Because you were consulted on the Non-Material Change application and submitted a response, we are now consulting you on this further amendment. Please note that comments should be limited to any potential impacts arising from the amendment only, this is not a further consultation on the wider application.

With this consultation letter we have included copies of:

- Our Covering Letter which sets out the nature of the proposed amendment in greater detail and assessment of its likely effects
- A revised Parameter Plan
