The intentions of E.D.F. for the Village of Combwich is causing great concern + distress.

I don't think anyone in the Village is against the Power Station, but we all want our Village to stay a Village, not the things E.D.F. want for us. We do not want to become a Port.

INDUSTRIAL ESTATE, Bus DEPO, Heavy Good DEPO, CONTAINER PARK or have a Factory for the construction of barges/jetsams for the Point, all of which will be working 24/7 - 4-5AM until 12pm. this will create noise + light pollution also traffic congestion for the whole area not just Combwich.

In stage ① of the consultations there was no mention of any of the above, that being so there was no opportunity to object at that time.

In stage ② they did not put on display their intentions in the Village Hall or make mention in the newsletters we received, if this information was anywhere it was + is hidden in their documentation, all 90,000/100,000 pages of it.

E.D.F.'s consultations were and are inadequate + devious to say the least.

E.D.F. is going to build a temporary jetty at the Point, why <sup>they</sup> can't build a permanent one or a road from Dumball to the Point.
