RE: CONSULTATION - EDF/HINKLEY POINT C.

We write further to our letter of 22nd. September.

In brief, I confirm that, 2 months ago, I was given first hand and detailed information regarding EDF's proposals for Combwich Wharf and the adjacent lorry park and freight terminal, by a professional who is involved in the project. EDF have been told that "it is an impossible dream". I am informed that Wynns have said that "it cannot be done" and that they are making provision to transport virtually 100% of freight by road.

Accordingly, what does this say for EDF's conduct and their claims of an open and transparent consultation?

Objection (10). We question the suitability of Hinkley Point as a site for a further Nuclear Power Station, given the historic details of the 1607 Bristol Channel Tsunami and the possibility or probability of a recurrence - see details on the internet under Bristol Channel Tsunami.
