<p>A:</p> <p>Nid ydym yn ymwybodol o enghraiff o brosiect / C106 lle mae mecanwaith tebyg i'r WNPOP wedi ei ddefnyddio. However, discussions are ongoing with the Applicant, IACC and WG in relation to the possible governance arrangements to be included as part of the S106 agreement.</i></p>

<p>A:</p> <p>Os yw arian ychwanegol yn cael ei dderbyn trwy'r Dreth Cyngor, matter i'r Cyngor fydd blaenoriaethu'r cyfryw arian yn ddibynnol ar yr amgylchiadau a'r trefniadau ariannu ar y pryd. Mae'n ymddangos mae'r unig daliad uniongyrchol o dan y Cytundeb 106 sydd wedi ei lunio ar hyn o bryd, fydd cyfraniad tuag at breswyl i weithwyr yn ystod y cyfnod adeiladu. Felly, nid yw'r ymddangos ar hyn o bryd y bydd cyfraniadau tuag at wasanaethau presennol yn y hir dymor. Fodd bynnag, gan fod negodi yn parhau mewn perthynas â'r cytundeb, mae GC yn dymuno cadw'r hawl i ymateb ymhellach.</p> <p><i>If additional funds are received through Council Tax, it will be a matter for the Council to prioritise such funds depending on the circumstances and funding arrangements at that time. It would appear that the only direct payment to GC as presently drafted in the 106 agreement would be the contribution towards workers accommodation during the construction period. Accordingly it is not anticipated that at present any direct contribution would cover an existing service long term. However, as negotiations are ongoing in respect of the agreement, GC would wish to reserve the right to comment further.</i></p>

<p>A:</p> <p>Mae angen i Horizon ymrwymo'n llawn i hyn a dylid cael ymrwymiad trwy'r DCO (A106) i fonitro meddiannaeth (gosod llety). Awgrymir na ddylai meddiannaeth fynd yn is na 85% ar gyfer unrhyw gyfnod o'r gwaith. Dylai ymrwymiad o'r fath arwain at ryddhau taliadau wrth gefn ychwanegol pe bai'r lefel feddiannaeth yn disgyn o dan 85% am gyfnod penodol. Dylid bod gofyn i Horizon ddefnyddio pa bynnag fesurau marchnata, cytundebol a phrisio sydd eu hangen i sicrhau y cyflawnir y lefel feddiannaeth gyfartalog o 85% yn TWA ac y caiff ei chynnal am gyfnod y gwaith.</p> <p><i>Binding commitments are required from Horizon and there should be a commitment through the DCO (S106) to monitor occupancy (lettings). It is suggested that that occupancy should not fall below 85% for any phase. Such a commitment should result in the release of additional contingency fund payments should occupancy fall below 85% for an agreed period. Horizon should be required to use whatever necessary marketing, contractual, and pricing measures to ensure that an average occupancy of 85% in TWA is achieved and maintained for the duration of the work.</i></p>

<p>A:</p> <p>Mae methodoleg Horizon ar gyfer cyfrifo 'lle y pen' yn y sector rhentu preifat wedi gor-gyfrif faint o le sydd ar gael a byddai angen i bron i chwarter pob lle gwag net yn y sector gael ei rentu gan weithwyr adeiladu dros y cyfnod pum mlynedd hyd at Bl7 Ch4. Byddai hyn yn cael effaith andwyol ar alw ac yn fwy na'r capasiti sydd ar gael.</p> <p>Mae Horizon wedi methu ag ystyried effaith gweithlu'n tyfu'n gyflym ar y marchnadoedd tai a thwristiaeth, gyda gofyn am 1,600 o wllâu mewn deuddeg mis ym Mlwyddyn 4, a 1,200 o'r rhain mewn cyfnod o 6 mis yn Ch3 a Ch4 Blwyddyn 4, a 700 o fewn un chwarter yn Ch4 Blwyddyn 4, sy'n afrealistig.</p>			

Mae Horizon yn dibynnu'n llwyr ar rymoedd y farchnad i ddiwallu'r galw am lety ychwanegol yn y sector preifat. Er bod y Cynllun Datblygu ar y Cyd Lleol (sy'n cynnwys Gwynedd ac Ynys Môn) wedi dynodi digon o safleoedd tai i ddiwallu twf mewn swyddi, prin iawn yw'r tebygolrwydd y bydd adeiladwyr tai preifat yn medru ymateb mewn pryd rhwng gweithredu'r DCO a phan fydd y galw'n cynyddu yn ystod Bl 4.

Nid yw Horizon wedi darparu unrhyw ddata o ran am faint o amser y bydd gwahanol garfannau o'r gweithlu yn bresennol ar y safle, na lefel y trosiant, sy'n ei gwneud yn amhosib amcangyfrif sut fydd y ddeiliadaeth yn cael ei rhannu rhwng pobl fydd yn prynu a phobl fydd yn rhentu, ac nid ydynt wedi llwyr werthfawrogi nifer tebygol y partneriaid a'r dibynyddion, sy'n mynd i gael effeithiau cysylltiedig ar dai teuluoedd, addysg, iechyd a sectorau eraill.

Horizon's methodology for calculating 'headroom' in the private rented sector has over calculated availability and would require nearly a quarter of all net vacancies in the sector being rented by construction workers over the five years up to Y7Q4 this would have an adverse impact upon demand and exceeds the capacity available.

Horizon have failed to consider the impact on the housing and tourism markets very rapid build -up of workforce numbers, requiring 1,600 bed spaces in the twelve months of Y4, with 1,200 of these in the six months of Y4Q3 and Y4Q4, and 700 within the single quarter of Y4Q4 which is unrealistic.

Horizon are relying entirely upon market forces to meet the demands for delivering additional private sector accommodation. While the Joint Local Development Plan (covering Gwynedd and Anglesey) has allocated sufficient housing sites to meet jobs led growth, there is little likelihood that private house builders will be able to respond in the time between DCO implementation and when the demand will increase during Y4.

Horizon have not provided any data on the length of time that different sections of the workforce will be present on site, nor level of churn making it impossible to estimate the tenure split between potential purchasers and renters, and have underestimated the likely numbers of partners and dependents, with associated implications for family housing, education, health and other sectors.

Er ein bod yn croesawu ac yn cefnogi darparu system borth, byddwn angen eglurder ar sut y byddai'n gweithredu a sut all gweithwyr gael eu hannog i ddefnyddio'r porth neu sut ellir diweddarau'r wybodaeth yn rheolaidd i sicrhau dilysrwydd y wybodaeth. Efallai y bydd gweithwyr yn fodlon cofrestru wrth gyrraedd, fodd bynnag, bydd angen adolygu'r sefyllfa'n barhaus er mwyn nodi unrhyw newidiadau ym mhatrwm ymddygiad a'r defnydd o wahanol

fathau o lety. Bydd heriau wrth gynnal gwybodaeth oherwydd y lefel uchel o drosiant a dibyniaeth ar weithwyr wedi'u contractio ar gyfer rhai meysydd o weithgarwch.

Whilst we welcome and support the provision of a portal we will require clarification on its operation and how workers can and would be compelled to use the portal or how information can be updated at regular intervals to ensure the validity of information. Workers may be willing to register on arrival however it will be necessary to review on an ongoing basis to identify any changes in patterns of behaviour and use of different types of accommodation. There will be challenges in maintaining information due to the high level of churn and a reliance on contracted workers in some areas of activity.

- 1) Nid ydym yn credu fod y dyraniad arfaethedig o £10m yn ddigonol. Cyfrannodd Cyngor Gwynedd, gyda Chyngor Sir Ynys Môn, Cyngor Bwrdeistrefol Sirol Conwy a Llywodraeth Cymru at yr Adroddiad gan 3 Dragons a oedd yn ymgeisio i gyfrifo lefel y mesurau lliniaru fyddai eu hangen. Roedd hwn yn awgrymu gwaelodlin llawer iawn uwch na'r ffigyrau a gyflwynwyd gan Horizon. Rydym yn pryderu nad yw graddfa a hyd cyfnod y datblygiad adeiladu wedi cael eu hystyried yn briodol yn eu hafaliadau a chredwn y bydd yr effeithiau'n ymestyn ar hyd y cyfnod adeiladu yn hytrach na chael eu cyfyngu hyd at y cyfnod prysuraf.

- 2) I leihau'r effaith, dylai'r arian fod ar gael mewn da bryd cyn cychwyn y gwaith i wneud y mwyaf o'r cyfleoedd i gyflawni newid a dylai gynnwys y cyfnod adeiladu yn ei gyfanrwydd.

- 1) *We do not believe that the proposed allocation of £10m is sufficient. Gwynedd Council along with the Isle of Anglesey County Council and Conwy Bountly Borough Council and Welsh Government contributed to the 3 Dragons Report which attempted to calculate the level of mitigation required. This suggested a baseline well in excess of the figures presented by Horizon. We are concerned that the scale and length of the development have not been appropriately factored into their equations and believe that impacts will extend across the construction period and not be confined up to the peak.*
- 2) *In order to maximize impact the funding should be available well in advance of commencement work to maximize opportunities to deliver change and should cover the construction period in its entirety.*
- 3) *It would be helpful if a larger proportion of funding was made available in advance as this would help ensure investment could be targeted towards pro-active interventions and allow new stock to be commissioned from house builders, developers and or social landlord to secure the number of stock required.*

- 1). Byddai gohirio cyflawni'r TWA yn arwain at orboethi'r farchnad a chanlyniad hynny fyddai prisiau rhent ac eiddo uwch fyddai'n dosbarthu'r galw'n ehangach i'r tir mawr gan ddadleoli niferoedd sylweddol o denantiaid presennol a phrynwyr tro cyntaf hefyd o bosib. Os yw eiddo'n trosglwyddo o fod yn gartrefi i fod yn rhan o'r farchnad rhentu preifat bydd hyn yn cael effaith ehangach ar gydlynid cymdeithasol o fewn cymunedau ac effeithiau andwyol ar yr iaith Gymraeg.
- 2). Rydym wedi awgrymu strategaeth gyfnod wahanol a all fod o fudd ond credwn y byddai trefniadau gwahanol yn angenrheidiol. Mae ofnau y byddai'n anodd newid neu ddadwneud ymddygiadau unwaith y maent wedi'u sefydlu.

3) Dylid cysylltu'r datblygiadau ar y safle i nifer y gweithwyr sydd ar y safle ac argaeledd y TWA. Dylai diffyg cydymffurfiaeth arwain at lefel uwch o fesurau lliniaru a dylai'r rhain fod yn llawer uwch na chost darparu'r unedau TWA.

Strategaeth fesul cam diwygiedig:

Croesawir y bwriad i gysylltu darapraiaeth y campws i lefel gweithwyr o adref. Pysig fod unedau yn cael ei darparu cyn ei bod eu hanges, ac hyn sefydlu patrymau o leoliadau cymunedol. Mae dal pryder y bydd yr angen yn fwy / ormod cyn i'r llety gael ei ddarparu.

Dylid darparu y 2000 olaf yn gynharach.

- 1). Delayed delivery of TWA would lead to overheating of the market resulting in rent and property price increases leading to a wider dispersal of demand onto the mainland with displacement of significant numbers of existing tenants and potentially first time buyers. If properties transfer from home ownership to private rent this will have wider impacts on social cohesion within communities and adverse impacts on the Welsh language.*
- 2). We have suggested an alternative phasing strategy which may help but believe that alternative arrangements would be necessary. There are fears that it would be difficult to change or reverse behaviours once they have established.*
- 3) Developments on site should be linked to the numbers of workers on the site and availability of TWA. Non adherence should result in increased level of mitigation which should be well in excess of the cost of providing the units of TWA.*

The amended Phasing Strategy:

We welcome the intention to link delivery of campus accommodation to level of non-home based workers. It is important that units are delivered and available in advance of need, before patterns of community location are established. Concerns remain that demand will have exceeded or be close to saturation before the accommodation is available. It would be helpful to bring delivery forward and to link workforce numbers to units of 500 rather than a 1000.

The requirement for the final 2000 in particular should be brought forward.

A Supply Chain Action Plan is required as soon as possible to ensure activity takes place to develop the capacity of local businesses to meet the anticipated demand.</i></p>			

Providing new opportunities for business in the locality and wider region, alongside job generation, is the primary benefit the area anticipates from Wylfa Newydd and is a key reason why Gwynedd Council and the wider community supports the development.

However, this opportunity will only be maximised through proactive action by the Developer and its contractors, working in partnership with stakeholders such as Anglesey and Gwynedd Councils, the Welsh Government and the North Wales Economic Ambition Board.

The development of a Supply Chain Action Plan is a key document which should:

- *articulate the ambition for local expenditure by HNP and its contractors and their commitment to realise this;*
- *the contractual requirements to be placed upon HNP’s contractors to support local suppliers;*
- *a clear analysis of the requirements for Wylfa Newydd including timelines;*
- *the actions to be undertaken to maximise the opportunities for local businesses from Wylfa Newydd;*
- *the resources to be committed by HNP – and other stakeholders - to realise the ambition;*
- *the practical arrangements for the management and delivery of the Action Plan;*
- *the steps to be taken to monitor the implementation of the Supply Chain Action Plan and its impact over time and across various spatial levels e.g. KSA, DCCZ, North Wales and Wales; and,*
- *the links / interrelationship between the Plan and other key document such as the Jobs and Skills Implementation Plan.*

As articulated in Gwynedd Council’s previous responses to the ExA, Gwynedd Council wishes to be fully involved in the development and delivery of the Supply Chain Action Plan.

Nododd Cyngor Gwynedd yn ei ymatebion blaenorol nod oedd wedi derbyn copi o’r Cynllun Gwireddu Swyddi a Sgiliau - mae hyn yn parhau i fod yr achos. Nid yw Cyngor Gwynedd yn hysbys o sail y £10 miliwn a gynhigir ar gyfer Cronfa Sgiliau a Chyflogaeth ac felly nid oes modd cynnig sylw ystyrlon ar dilysrwydd a phirdoldeb y swm. Fodd bynnag nodwn fod Llywodraeth Cymru yn awgrymu fod y sŵn yn annigonol ac y dylid sicrhau £21 miliwn i'r pwrpas ac rydym yn gefnogol i'w hasesiad o'r angen.

Fel a nodwyd yn flaenorol i'r ExA mae'r Cyngor o'r farn fod y risg o ddadleoli swyddi yn sylweddol uwch na'r hyn a aseswyd gan HNP. Yn hyn o beth, mae'n allweddol bwysig fod darpariaeth digonol yn cael ei sicrhau drwy law y DCO i gwrdd â anghenion uniongyrchol Wylfa Newydd ac i gefnogi ôl-lenwi y swyddi o fewn busnesau lleol fydd yn colli cyflogai i'r cynllun, ac i'r perwyl yma dylid cyfeirio'r Gronfa Sgiliau a Cyflogaeth yn bennaf.. Yn nghyflawni'r perwyl credwn fod yn bwysig sicrhau dull gweithredu allblyg gan ystyried yr angen i ddatblygu sgiliau o fewn yr ystod meysydd y bydd galw ynddynt o ganlyniad i Wylfa Newydd (all amrywio o beirianeg i arlwyo) ac, o gofio fod datblygu sgiliau unigolion yn broses hir, fod y Gronfa yn weithredol yn unionsyth wedi i'r DCO gael ei ganiatáu ac yn parhau hyd at fod y ddau adweithydd yn gwbwl weithredol.

Gwynedd Council is not aware of the basis of the £10 million proposed for the Employment and Skills Fund and therefore cannot provide a considered view on the appropriateness or validity of the sum. However we note that the Welsh Government have suggested that the sum is inadequate and that £21 million should be secured for this purpose and we are support their assessment of the need.

As noted previously to the ExA the Council is of the opinion that the risk of displacement is significantly higher than as assessed by HNP. IN light of this it is critically important that sufficient provision is secured via the DCO to meet the direct needs of Wylfa Newydd and to support the backfilling of posts within local businesses losing employees to the project, and it is to this end that the Employment & Skills Fund should primarily be directed. Monitoring for aspects such as education and the immersion services should be monitored every term of the school year in order to keep track of any changes. Other mitigations for more general aspects such as the workforce could be monitored and reported yearly, but the scope and detail would have to be agreed with the Welsh language and Culture Engagement Group.
