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1 DCO S.106 Agreement Status Note

1.1 Deadline 6 updated draft s.106 agreement

- 1.1.1 This note provides an update to the Examining Authority on the current draft of the DCO s.106 agreement, as submitted at Deadline 6, and the status of negotiations.
- 1.1.2 At Deadline 5 Horizon provided its revised draft s.106 agreement dated 23 January 2019. Since the issue of that version, Horizon has received detailed comments from IACC and the Welsh Government. It has also had extensive engagement with IACC on all schedules, and engagements including through the statements of common ground process with other stakeholders.
- 1.1.3 Those comments, meetings and discussions have informed the further draft agreement now submitted at Deadline 6.
- 1.1.4 For avoidance of doubt, this version of the agreement submitted at Deadline 6 represents the current position of Horizon, and the table below sets out a high level overview of material issues not yet agreed on the s106 agreement with IACC and the Welsh Government. (For avoidance of doubt this table does not list each outstanding issue, but focuses on the main areas/themes not yet agreed.)
- 1.1.5 In terms of ongoing negotiations, further meetings are being scheduled including with IACC, Welsh Government and Gwynedd Council for the week commencing 25th February.
- 1.1.6 Horizon notes the revised timetable for provision of final (Deadline 8) and signed (Deadline 9) versions of the s.106 agreement and is committed to working with stakeholders to meet those deadlines.
