Clarification on the status of the SoCG between Horizon Nuclear Power and Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru (CNC) / Natural Resources Wales (NRW) – Our ref: 20011606

Dear Kay Sully,

Further to Horizon's submissions at Deadline 6, we write to provide clarification on the status of the Statement of Common Ground between Horizon and NRW submitted for Deadline 6.

Section 4 (para 4.1.5) of the SoCG states "*this final SOCG is submitted at Deadline 6 and reflects the positions of NRW and Horizon at the point of submission*". Also, Table 2-1 of the Statement of Commonality for SoCG refers to the document between Horizon and NRW as being a 'Final SoCG'.

Please note, in the time available for review of the draft SoCG, it has not been possible to reach full agreement between both parties that the document is a mutually agreed draft. **NRW therefore consider the status of the SoCG submitted at Deadline 6 to be a 'Final draft'**. NRW had requested Horizon to make this clear when submitting the SoCG on behalf of both parties.

NRW would be committed to agreeing a final SoCG at the next available deadline should the Examining Authority consider that to be acceptable.
