> Thank you for your email concerning attendance at the Open Floor Hearing which will start at 7pm tomorrow (doors open at 6.30pm) it is important that anyone who wishes to attend / speak at the hearing is available from the start as the hearing will close promptly once oral submissions have been made by those parties present.

> As the application for the Wylfa Newydd Draft Development Consent Order is still in examination, and the Applicant has not withdrawn it, the Examining Authority (panel of Inspectors) are required by the Planning Act 2008 to examine the application that is before them.

> The purpose of the Open Floor Hearing is for Interested Parties to orally put forward their views (subject to the ExA's powers of control over the conduct of the hearing) to make oral representations about the application. If on the day there are other individuals present who wish to make submissions it will be open to the ExA to use its discretion to hear these should time permit.
