### **Cais gan Horizon Nuclear Power am Orchymyn yn Rhoi Caniatâd Datblygu ar gyfer Prosiect Wylfa Newydd**

#### **Cais am Wybodaeth Ychwanegol**

Cyflwynodd yr Ymgeisydd gais am Drwydded Safle Niwclear ar 31 Mawrth 2019 o dan Ddeddf Safleoedd Niwclear 1965 [REP4-026]. Mae wedi rhoi gwybod ers hynny bod y cais am Drwydded Safle Niwclear wedi cael ei dynnu'n ôl a'i fod yn argymhell bod cyngor ar y drwydded yn cael ei geisio'n uniongyrchol gan y Swyddfa Rheoleiddio Niwclear (ONR) [REP6-017 a REP7-001].

Mae EN6 Adran 2.7 yn cyfeirio at y berthynas rhwng y gyfundrefn reoleiddio ar gyfer gorsafoedd pŵer niwclear a'r gyfundrefn gynllunio. Yn arbennig, 2.7 sy'n datgan: "Os yw'r broses cymeradwyaethau rheoleiddiol yn anghyflawn, dylai'r Comisiwn Cynllunio Seilwaith (IPC) hefyd geisio cyngor gan y Rheoleiddwyr Niwclear perthnasol ar unrhyw ofynion rheoleiddiol sy'n debygol o fod yn gysylltiedig, ac amseriad disgwylidig y prosesau hyn, a dylai'r IPC gysylltu â'r Rheoleiddwyr Niwclear ynglŷn ag unrhyw ofynion perthnasol y mae'n ystyried eu cysylltu â chaniatâd datblygu. Diben hyn yw sicrhau, lle y bo'n bosibl, bod y gofynion sy'n gysylltiedig â gorchymyn caniatâd datblygu yn gyson â'r broses cymeradwyaethau rheoleiddiol, ac fel arall."

Beth yw safbwynt yr ONR ynglŷn â'r cyngor a roddir ar y materion hyn yn EN-6? Ymatebwch erbyn Terfyn Amser 10 yr Archwiliad, os gwelwch yn dda.

**Application by Horizon Nuclear Power for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Wylfa Newydd Project**

**Request for Further Information**

The Applicant submitted an application for a Nuclear Site Licence on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019 under the Nuclear Installations Act 1965 [REP4-026]. It has since advised that the application for a Nuclear Site Licence has been withdrawn and recommends that advice on the licence be obtained directly from ONR [REP6-017 and REP7-001].

EN6 Section 2.7 refers to the relationship between the regulatory regime for nuclear power stations and the planning regime. In particular, 2.7 which states: "If the regulatory approvals process is incomplete the IPC should also seek advice from the relevant Nuclear Regulators on any regulatory requirements that are likely to be attached and the anticipated timing of these processes and the IPC should liaise with the Nuclear Regulators over any relevant requirements it is considering attaching to a development consent. This is in order to ensure that where possible the requirements attached to a development consent order are consistent with the regulatory approvals process and vice versa."

Having regard to the advice set out in EN-6 and the proposed delay in delivering the project, what is the position of the ONR in relation to the likelihood of a nuclear site licence being issued in due course and what requirements does ONR consider should be imposed on any DCO, should one be made?

Does the ONR have any comments in relation to "the capability, organisation and resources of the applicant corporate body" which will need to be addressed when any application for a site licence is re submitted?

Please respond by Deadline 10 of the Examination.
