We act for Network Rail Infrastructure Limited (**Network Rail**).

With regards to the Examining Authority's (**ExA**) Written Question 17.2.7, we respond as follows:

ExA's Written Question 17.2.7

Network Rail and the undertaker (together, the Parties) are in discussions regarding the agreements to be entered into to enable the Order works, which affect Network Rail property, to be undertaken by way of private agreement with Network Rail.

As the ExA is aware, and as stated in Network Rail's Relevant Representation [RR-089] and further representations, Network Rail can only withdraw its objection if it agrees matters privately with the undertaker in order to safeguard Network Rail's undertaking and ensure that compulsory acquisition powers are not exercised in respect of Network Rail property.

The Parties are considering entering into a framework agreement and a licence agreement to enable the Works to be carried out.

The Parties intend to submit a joint report to the ExA at Deadline 10 regarding these documents and the protective provisions for the benefit of Network Rail.
