#### Availability of 'local workforce' with Nuclear Relevant Skills

The examination panel will recall that the NACP raised concerns during the Open Floor Hearing on the 5th March that the 'local workforce' recruitment estimates for north Anglesey / Anglesey in APP-096 may be over optimistic. It is the NACP's view that this may impact accommodation requirements, may impact traffic calculations, may result in significant local displacement, may require substantial further investment in the area of training and/or retraining and may require a redoubling of efforts to contact suitably skilled workers who may have left the area to seek work.

Since September 2018 the NACP have repeatedly requested that in addition to the DCCZ figures for the 'pool' of workers / claimants with 'nuclear relevant skills' that the applicant also supply data for the smaller geographic areas of north Anglesey, Anglesey and the 60 minute travel to work area so that the impact of the 'local workforce' recruitment can be assessed.

The information has now been made available to the NACP in REP8-012.

The NACP understand that 'confidentiality' will have some impact on the north Anglesey figure but is unlikely to be significant at the Anglesey or 60 min travel to work area.

However, there appears to be a significant unexplained anomaly between the cumulative figures presented for the 'Mechanical and electrical operatives' in REP8-012 and APP-096.

#### REP8-012 Figures workers / claimants

North Anglesey: 1189, 20

Anglesey: 5092, 65

60 min: 10461,105

#### REP-096 Figures workers / claimants

90 min: 2725, 10

As the figures are cumulative the numbers should increase as the area expands. The REP8-012 figures appear extremely high especially when compared with the Civil Engineering Operatives and Site Services, Security and Clerical Staff sectors.

The NACP have emailed the applicant directly to seek clarification of the figures presented. Due to the reduction in Horizon's workforce the NACP have been informed that the applicant is unable to respond at this time but will respond to a Deadline 9 submission at Deadline 10. Unfortunately, the NACP will then be unable to respond to the applicant's submission within the examination timetable. It is the NACP's view that this is unacceptable.
