Wylfa Newydd DCO Project: Response to Secretary of State's Request for Further Information.

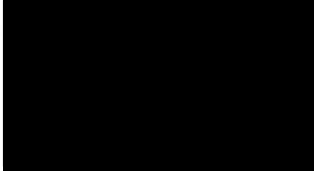
- *Appendix 1:* An updated Other Consents and Licences Document (this updates the previous version provided during examination [REP6-017]);

Following receipt of the Request Letter, Horizon engaged with a range of stakeholders, including attending meetings and calls during November and December with Natural Resources Wales, Isle of Anglesey County Council, Welsh Government, Cadw, the Gwynedd Archaeological Planning Service, and representatives of National Trust, North Wales Wildlife Trust, and RSPB.

This engagement provided Horizon with the opportunity to discuss the current status of the matters raised in the Response Letter with stakeholders (including progress since the close of Examination) and to reach agreement on outstanding matters where possible. Horizon's responses therefore reflect the discussions that have been held with stakeholders and further agreements reached during this period.
