I have been responsible for the farm alone since 1954. later I was joined by my son, I have now retired. My wife and I live in the farm house, adjacent to the farm yard which my son and daughter have. This area is only separated by a small strip of land next to E.D.F land where they propose to develop.

I am concerned for security measures, 2500 men with nothing to do in the evenings with only a strip of land separating them from property & farm equipment etc.

I have mentioned to E.D.F representatives several times but there is no reference to a fence or a bend in the application or maps.

Also I have concerns about the exit from the farm and drive and Old Peoples Home onto the road, for have slow moving and bulky farm machinery.

Perhaps some kind of signage at least?

I may also point out that should <sup>this work</sup> go ahead no arrangement with my son to correct <sup>the</sup> damage an inconvenience caused to facilitating such as irrigation & other matters on the farm, I hope E.D.F will consider these matters.

E.D.F have somehow arranged for sea deliveries & more train deliveries.

Nearer back to not needing the Sizer Hill link road?

When go 60m.p.h & wider verges? the A 12 has 40.m.p.h stratches & will still be in busy use after the completion of the power station.
