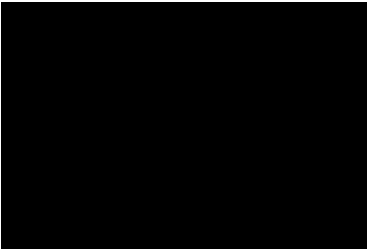

Unfortunately we are unable to attend the Preliminary Meetings to discuss the Examination procedures for this application but we would like to make some comments relating to the Agenda for the meetings.

Agenda Item 4 – Assessment of Principal Issues

You state in your Rule 6 letter that the Issues detailed in Annex C are based on Relevant Representations made by ourselves and every other Interested Party. Since those Relevant Representations were written SZC have made significant changes to their DCO, acceptance of which you have not yet decided. If you do accept the changes then surely the Principal Issues may change. Assessment of Principal Issues should be discussed after your decision as to whether or not to accept the changes.

Agenda Item 5 - The Applicant's proposed changes to the application

We, as everyone else, are under many stresses and pressures related to Covid-19, Scottish Power Renewables applications for windfarm DCOs in addition to personal issues. It's very difficult to consider SZC's application and prepare Written Representations without knowing whether or not you will accept the changes EDF are proposing because we don't know what to respond to.

Agenda Item 6 - Draft Examination Timetable

The timetable will be difficult for many people to adequately consider and prepare for.

We're unlikely to consider a holiday this summer but many people will wish to take one when the current Covid-19 restrictions come to an end. How will they be able to properly engage with the Examination?

Suffolk County Council elections are to be held on 6 May and the Council will be in purdah for the six weeks prior to then. It is likely this will affect the Council's engagement with and proper representation in the Examination which is a grave concern.

Scottish Power Renewables DCOs remain under Examination until 6 April. The County Council, East Suffolk Council, other bodies and many individuals are as concerned with those DCOs as with SZC's and this timetable puts more pressure on everyone.

As all of the points above are relevant will you please delay the Preliminary Meetings?
