Agenda Item 4 covers Initial Assessment of Principal Issues to be examined. However, it is not clear if this based on Relevant Representations by September 2020 or whether it will also include any additional or different issues arising from SZC's submission of revised proposals made after September 2020.

To enable informed representations on the Principal Issues during the examination, it would be helpful to have the above clarified. This would ensure that the list of Principal issues is as comprehensive as possible and give certainty as to which submissions/versions of the SZC proposals future representations are to be made.
