SEAS is one of the community groups involved in the six month examination of ScottishPower Renewables DCO application for Wind Farms: East Anglia North One (EAN1) and East Anglia Two (EA2)

You may be aware that the Secretary of State Kwasi Kwarteng BEIS has extended the examinations by three months ending in July 2021.

The examination which should have come to an end on 6th April 2021 will now crash into the Sizewell C examination.

I am sure you will understand that, having gone through six months of the complicated 'double' examination of EAN1 & EA2, the participating Interested Parties, Affected Parties, Community Groups and Statutory Stakeholder's resources, and energy are very much depleted and the further strain of an additional examination may be detrimental to the participants physical and mental health.

We have grave concerns that our members, many of whom are Interested Parties in the Sizewell C project, will be unable to give their full attention to both examinations.
