Notification of Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI)

We write to all Interested Parties to announce the dates, times, and meeting places for the Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI) from Tuesday 8 to Thursday 10 June 2021 and the ASI to Hinkley Point C on Tuesday 22 June 2021. These are set out at Annex A to this letter.

The Examining Authority (ExA) are grateful for the submission of suggested locations for the ASI at both Procedural Deadline B and Deadline 1. Careful consideration has been given to the suggested locations and the final itinerary has now been published on the Project page of the National Infrastructure Planning website:

A significant number of the suggested locations are accessible from public land. As the ExA can conduct Unaccompanied Site Inspections (USI) throughout the Examination, those locations which do not form part of the ASI and are considered relevant may be visited as part of a further USI. A note will be published on the Project page of the National Infrastructure Planning website detailing any further USIs undertaken.

The Panel would like to remind all attendees that the purpose of the site inspection is to view the site and surroundings in the context of the written material. No oral or written representations should be made, or discussions on points of merit conducted, at the inspection.

Due to the requirement to wear PPE whilst on the Main Development site and security requirements, and because capacity on the vehicles that will be used for the ASI is limited, only those who notified the ExA by Deadline 1 that they wished to attend the ASI will be able to attend. The Case Team will contact those parties in due course to finalise attendance registration details which must be confirmed by **23:59 on Tuesday 1 June 2021**.

(COVID-19) Coronavirus considerations

Those attending the ASI should note the following:

- All attendees will be required to have a lateral flow test before participating in the inspection. This will be arranged by the Applicant and further information is contained in the final itinerary.
- Face masks must be worn by all attendees within buildings and vehicles unless exempt.
- Due to the need to use specific vehicles (4X4s) to visit the Main Development Site (MDS) it is not possible for attendees to be socially distant within the vehicles, however windows will be open to ensure good ventilation.
- Where the site inspection involves the use of a coach attendees will be allocated a seat to ensure that everyone has as much space as possible. Windows will be open where available to ensure good ventilation.

Itinerary

Access onto private land is at all times by permission of the person controlling it; householders, occupiers and landowners may refuse to allow some persons accompanying the ExA onto their land. Under those circumstances, the ExA will decide whether or not to proceed with that part of the inspection.

Please note that if any of the events scheduled at Annex A are no longer required, reasonable notice will be provided to Interested Parties of our decision to cancel them. This will include a notice published on the Project page of the National Infrastructure Planning website. If you have any further queries, please do not hesitate to contact the Case Team.
