*LONDON, 3 June, 2021* - To maintain the assertion that it is still a key part of the struggle to limit the climate crisis, the global nuclear industry's propaganda war is unremitting in its attempt to avoid oblivion in the world's democracies. At stake are thousands of well-paid power station jobs, but also a potential rise in electricity prices if funds are diverted away from cheaper options for generating power.
