1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1.1 Fifteen proposed changes to the Sizewell C Project were accepted for examination by the Examining Authority on 21 April 2021 ('the Accepted Changes') [\[PD-013\]](#). After the Accepted Changes were accepted, SZC Co. carried out publicity that reflects the requirements of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 to publicise that SZC Co. had submitted supplementary environmental information to the Planning Inspectorate that supplemented or changed the Environmental Statement.
- 1.1.2 Persons were able to submit responses to this publicity to SZC Co. from 28 April 2021 to midday on 7 June 2021. SZC Co. received two responses.
- 1.1.3 Appendix A of this report provides copies of the two responses received, from which personal details (such as names and email addresses) have been redacted. Section 2 of this report provides SZC Co.'s comments on those responses.
