

Summary of Written Representation for Deadline 3 on behalf of N J Bacon Farms, Ward Farming Ltd, A W Bacon Will Trust and Nat & India Bacon

Our written representation for Deadline 3 include the following concerns:

- **Ecology**

The suitability and criteria for selection of the marsh harrier habitat site at Grange Farm, Westleton

- **SLR**

A technical note from Create Consulting Engineers regarding:

- Consideration of the direct effects of the B1125/B1122/SLR on the Bacon Family's land interests beyond the DL2 submission made.
- The Applicant's proposals for the B1125/B1122 altered priority arrangements with a direct connection between the B1125 and proposed SLR to the South will lead to a increase in Sizewell and general traffic along a route already prone to accidents with sub-standard alignment and lacking pedestrian amenity.
- The fact that this is not considered by the Applicants Road Safety Audit.
- The Traffic Incident Management Plan (Rev 2.0) and Construction Traffic Management Plan (Rev 2.0) both acknowledge that the B1125 route between the A12 and SLR is inadequate given that both documents now require that no movements for construction are to use the B1125 and so by implication, it is illogical for this route to be made more attractive for general traffic on the network (which the current proposals clearly have the potential to give rise to).
- Create requests the Applicant revisits the B1125/B1122 strategy particularly in terms of the proposed B1122/B1125 junction format, the potential disbenefits of a direct connection between the B1125 and SLR and general measures along the B1125 to offer a permanent legacy benefit to the local area.
