Dear Sir/Madam

I am writing to object to the Sizewell C project for the following reasons:

- It is not clear that a nuclear project of this scale is needed – it is hard reliably to predict demand for electricity 15+ years ahead;
- The huge investment in Sizewell C would necessarily mean that other opportunities would suffer as a result: less money would be available for other energy-related projects;
- Cost-effective electricity storage technology is improving at quite a pace: this will help to smooth the peaks and troughs of electricity demand, thereby reducing the need for so much generating capacity;
- Better management of consumption itself (eg a fridge operating in response not only to temperature, but also to the relative demand/cost of supply of electricity at any time) will likewise smooth peaks in demand; and
- If a vast new nuclear capability is truly needed, a more remote and far less environmentally-sensitive site should be chosen.

I trust that you will feel able to rule against this extremely costly and devastating project.
