Written Representation in respect of Application by NNB Generation Company (SZC) Limited for an Order Granting Development Consent for The Sizewell C Project

This response is offered without prejudice as there remain far too many outstanding commitments from the Applicant/EDF.

Fundamental outstanding Deadline 5 Consultation procedural issues.

Significant Key Stakeholder's.

Traffic and Transport

- How can the Applicant state the proposed SLR will provide such a legacy in one document, but just a haul road in another?
- The Applicant has still not provided satisfactory evidence in support of their decision not to use the alternative D2/Route W North.

The current Fordley Road SLR junction proposal by the Applicant remains a huge and grave concern particularly for significant Key Stakeholders, Mr & Mrs Lacey.

- The proposed Fordley Road SLR junction continues to have many vitally important issues of concern.
- Issues linked to rat running/congestion and road blocks regarding Fordley Road junction will have a huge detrimental effect for all Fordley Road residents.
- Issues linked to Risk to Life and Risk to Property have not been addressed by the Applicant.
- Issues linked to emissions from the two roads being a huge health concern to Mr & Mrs Lacey.
- It is completely unacceptable for the proposed SLR to be sited approximately 120 metres from [REDACTED].

The Applicant has acknowledged and recognised all the issues mentioned above.

All of the above issues remain outstanding between the Applicant and Mr & Mrs Lacey with **no** satisfactory resolve to date, having yet been agreed.

Landscape & Visual Impact

The current proposed land, noise and visual impacts regarding the proposed SLR surrounding Oakfield House remain to be significant concerns to Mr & Mrs Lacey.

The following issues remain outstanding between the Applicant and Mr & Mrs Lacey.

Air Quality/Planting

- The Applicant has failed to provide Mr & Mrs Lacey accurate mitigation proposals.

Noise and Vibration

- The Applicant has failed to provide Mr & Mrs Lacey accurate mitigation proposals.

Light Pollution

- The Applicant has failed to provide Mr & Mrs Lacey accurate mitigation proposals.

The Applicant has acknowledged and recognised the request for all above mitigation proposals.

However, all of the above issues remain outstanding between the Applicant and Mr & Mrs Lacey as **no** resolve to date, has yet been agreed.

Biodiversity

- Please refer to Kelsale cum Carlton Parish Council's Biodiversity/Ecology Report, which confirms important concerns, of why not to allow rat running through Kelsale Village, Butchers Road, Tiggins Lane and Fordley Road.

The Applicant has failed to provide an accurate and detailed report covering the above areas.

The Applicant has acknowledged the importance of biodiversity but confirmed will not be providing any further information, leaving the Applicant's reports completely inadequate and unacceptable.

Mr & Mrs Lacey would like to work with the Applicant to resolve all of the above mentioned outstanding matters.
