Application EN010012 for The Sizewell C Project by NNB Generation Company (SZC) Limited ("SZC Co.")

Further to the publication of the Rule 8 letter on 21 April 2021 (Examination Library ref. [PD-015](#)) and the Rule 8(3) and Rule 17 letter published on 18 June 2021 (Examination Library ref. [PD-027](#)), we write to provide SZC Co.'s written submissions for Deadline 5.

Please note that SZC Co. is also submitting a request for further changes to the Application on this date (23 July 2021) under a separate cover letter. Please refer to Section 5 of this letter for details.

1. SZC Co.'s Deadline 5 Submissions

Appendix A of this letter contains a table that lists the Deadline 5 submissions made on behalf of SZC Co. For each document, the table provides the document name, reference, description and confirmation of whether it is a standalone document or supersedes a previously submitted document. The table provides a brief description of the document and the reason for its submission.

2. Update on other document submissions

Whilst a number of documents are being submitted today, we are conscious of the volume of material and there are three documents which we have thought it best not to submit, for the reasons explained below. SZC Co. wishes to minimise the number of updated versions of application documents that are submitted throughout the Examination to lessen the amount of time that Interested Parties and the Examining Authority need to spend reviewing documents at each Examination deadline. Therefore, unless otherwise requested by the Examining Authority, SZC Co.'s approach is only to submit an updated version when substantive updates to a document have been made.

i) Outline Site Waste Management Plan

In SZC Co.'s responses to the Examining Authority's First Written Questions (ExQ1) (Examination Library ref. [REP2-100](#)), at question W.1.12, SZC Co. said it intended to submit an annex to the Outline Site Waste Management Plan, as provided in Volume 2, Appendix 8A of the Environmental Statement (Examination Library ref. [APP-194](#)) at Deadline 5. SZC Co. has since agreed with the Environment Agency (EA) that it will consult with the EA on the new annex before submission. SZC Co. proposes to submit this annex at Deadline 7 to allow time for consultation with the EA. We trust that this approach is acceptable to the Examining Authority.

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ii) Outline Drainage Strategy

The intended updates to the Outline Drainage Strategy (Examination Library ref. [REP2-033](#)) at this Deadline 5 were to be minor and non-substantive. Therefore, SZC Co. intends to submit the next iteration of the Outline Drainage Strategy at Deadline 7, which would accommodate the findings and evolved designs set out in the suite of MDS and AD preliminary drainage design notes that are included within this Deadline 5 submission. These notes contain key technical data demonstrating the efficiency and effectiveness of the proposed drainage infrastructure and directly address key concerns of stakeholders, having been shared informally in advance of submission to the Examining Authority.

iii) Water Supply Strategy

SZC Co. will provide a progress update on SZC Co.'s Water Supply Strategy at Deadline 6 and intends to submit the Water Supply Strategy at Deadline 7. Please refer to Section 6 of this letter for a further update on matters relating to water supply.

3. New Issues Arising in respect of the Additional Land at Pakenham (Change 11)

Annex B of the Rule 8(3) and Rule 17 letter published on 18 June 2021 (Examination Library ref. [PD-027](#)) identifies new issues arising in relation to the additional land at Pakenham (Change 11). **Table 1** sets out the new issues and where SZC Co. has responded to each new issue in its submissions.

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4. Statements of Common Ground Update

For a number of Statements of Common Ground, discussions are ongoing with the relevant stakeholder but there has not been a substantial update to warrant an updated Statement of Common Ground being submitted at this Deadline 5. **Table 2** provides an update on the status of the Statements of Common Ground which are not being submitted at Deadline 5.

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5. Submission of Proposed Changes

As stated above, SZC Co. is also submitting a request for further changes to the Application on this date (23 July 2021) under a separate cover letter. Those proposed changes have arisen as a result of ongoing engagement between SZC Co. and stakeholders, including as part of the process of agreeing common ground and ongoing design development. The Proposed Changes were the subject of a Notification Report (Examination Library ref. [REP2-131](#)) submitted to the Examining Authority at Deadline 2. Consultation on the proposed changes was carried out between 11 June and midday 12 July 2021.

The proposed changes are summarised in **Table 3**.

6. Water Supply

Northumbrian Water Limited (NWL) has indicated that Sizewell C's peak demand of 4MI/day is likely to be achievable based on its recently completed interim WINEP report, which is under review by the Environment Agency and Natural England. Recent studies by NWL indicate that the new transfer main will not now be available until December 2024 at the earliest. This is approximately 2 years after the assumed start of construction. NWL has now confirmed that there is no spare capacity available within the local Blyth Water Resource Zone. Therefore, a temporary desalination plant is proposed to meet the project's potable water needs for part of the construction period before the transfer main is available. Once the transfer main has been constructed, the temporary desalination plant would be removed.

The proposed temporary desalination plant would comprise an intake pipe with screen, an outfall pipe with diffuser, and associated onshore pumping station and plant.

We consider this will necessitate a change to our application for development consent. We intend to consult on that change imminently and in parallel will submit a formal notification to the Planning Inspectorate. Both steps will be completed prior to the submission of a change application.

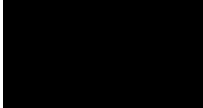
In terms of the consultation, early engagement is currently being undertaken with host local authorities and other key stakeholders. Separately, SZC Co. will consult local authorities, prescribed consultees, persons with an interest in land affected by the proposed changes, as well as members of the public. SZC Co. will publicise the consultation (through a newsletter, notice in local newspapers, its website and other methods) applying the same methods used in support of its previous consultations relating to proposed changes. It will make available a Consultation Document which describes the proposed changes and provides preliminary environmental information.
