Application EN010012 for The Sizewell C Project by NNB Generation Company (SZC) Limited ("SZC Co.")

Further to the publication of the Rule 8 letter on 21 April 2021 (Examination Library ref. <u>PD-015</u>) and the Rule 8(3) and Rule 17 letter published on 18 June 2021 (Examination Library ref. <u>PD-027</u>), we write to provide SZC Co.'s written submissions for Deadline 7.

1. SZC Co.'s Deadline 7 Submissions

Appendix A of this letter contains a table that lists the Deadline 7 submissions made on behalf of SZC Co.

For each document, the table provides the document name, reference, description and confirmation of whether it is a standalone document or supersedes a previously submitted document. The table provides a brief description of the document and the reason for its submission.

2. Proposed Change 19: Temporary Desalination Plant

SZC Co. is also submitting a request for a further change to the Application under a separate cover letter. As a result of ongoing engagement with Northumbrian Water Limited ('NWL'), SZC Co. identified a further proposed change that it wishes to make to the Application referred to as Proposed Change 19: Temporary Desalination Plant.

Due to capacity constraints within the local Blyth Water Resource Zone, a temporary desalination plant is proposed to meet the Project's potable water needs for part of the construction period, before a new transfer main is provided by NWL. The proposed temporary desalination plant would comprise an intake pipe with screen, an outfall pipe with diffuser, and associated onshore pumping station and plant. Once the transfer main has been constructed, the temporary desalination plant would be removed.

Consultation on Proposed Change 19 relating to the temporary desalination plant was carried out between 3 August 2021 and midnight on 27 August 2021.

3. Proposed Order limits reductions

As explained at the Compulsory Acquisition Hearing 1 Part 1 on 17 August 2021, SZC Co. is proposing to reduce the Order limits at the three fen meadow sites, the Sizewell link road and the green rail route. Appendix A to the Written Submissions Arising from Compulsory Acquisition Hearing 1 Part 1 (Doc Ref. 9.76) identifies indicatively the land that



SZC Co. proposes to remove from the Order limits and explains why SZC Co. considers that this land should be removed. SZC Co. will provide confirmation at Deadline 8 of the reductions to the Order limits and will at the same time submit a revised set of application documents and plans to reflect the reductions.

Discussions are ongoing between SZC Co. and the owners of the land to be removed. It is not considered that any further engagement or consultation is required before this change to the Order limits could be accepted for examination. Interested Parties will have the opportunity to comment on this, should they wish to do so, throughout the remainder of the examination.

4. National Policy Statement Tracker

SZC Co. wishes to minimise the number of updated versions of application documents that are submitted throughout the examination to lessen the amount of time that Interested Parties and the Examining Authority need to spend reviewing documents at each examination deadline. Therefore, unless otherwise requested by the Examining Authority, SZC Co.'s approach is only to submit an updated version when substantive updates to a document have been made.

For the National Policy Statement Tracker (Examination Library ref. <u>REP6-022</u>), only referencing updates would be made at this Deadline 7, whereas at Deadline 8 (24 September 2021), SZC Co. intends to offer a more comprehensive update to the ecology related policies in the National Policy Statement Tracker. SZC Co. intends to submit the next version of the National Policy Statement Tracker at Deadline 8 rather than at this Deadline 7.

5. Statements of Common Ground (SoCG) Update

Engagement with each stakeholders continues and we are grateful to them for their ongoing inputs and expertise. The Statement of Commonality (Doc Ref. 9.10(D)) provides an update on the status of each SoCG and identifies those submitted at this deadline and when others will be submitted at subsequent deadlines.

SZC Co. and the local authorities had intended to submit their updated SocG at this deadline. However, it was agreed that priority should be given to developing the draft Deed of Obligation (Doc Ref. 8.17(F)). SZC Co. believes that the substantive elements of the draft Deed of Obligation are now agreed in principle between the parties; and will collectively continue to develop the detailed wording of the agreement prior to it being finalised before the end of the examination. The parties intend to submit an updated SoCG at Deadline 8, which will focus on the fewer, specific matters that remain at that stage.
