

**Kelsale-cum-Carlton Parish Council Written Summary of Oral Submission (and update) to Issue Specific Hearing 11 on Flooding, Water & Coastal Processes  
For Deadline 8, 24th September 2021**



**2. Water Supply**

Kelsale-cum-Carlton Parish Council (KcCPC) wish the Applicant to clarify the following in respect of their proposals for a potable water supply to the Associated Development Sites:

- a. Where will this potable water be supplied from, and in what quantities for each site?
- b. To be explicit, will this be drawn from; the existing mains local water supply near each proposed Associated Development Site; transferred by tanker from elsewhere or something else, if so what?
- c. If it is to be supplied by tanker, are all these movements included in the existing 'tanker/HGV' assessment?
- d. If it is to be supplied by abstraction, how will this be arranged bearing in mind current Environment Agency issues with abstraction licencing?
- e. What increase in pollution will be created as a consequence of the supply of potable water for construction of Associated Development Sites?
- f. Is the volume of this water included within the figures referred to by Northumbrian Water Sizewell C Co (peak 4MI/d mains water supply to the Sizewell C site during construction and up to 2.8MI/d of mains water once the power station is operational) in their letter of 10<sup>th</sup> September 2021 or in addition to?
- g. What arrangements will be made for supply of non-potable water at these sites?
- h. What arrangements will be made for foul, surface water and residual non potable waste after use (i.e. vehicle cleaning, etc.) on these sites during construction.

**4. Associated Development Site Flood Risk Assessment**

a KcCPC draw attention to concerns expressed by residents about flood risk assessments on the Sizewell Link Road/Fordley Road.
