Dear Sir

It is with utter amazement that I learnt that EDF have failed to consider potable water when preparing their case for their proposal to build Sizewell C. It is such a fundamental issue to be overlooked that it gives me extreme concern about their competency. Their proposed remedy to tanker in 40 m litres a day during the build phase is totally unacceptable. The area is already due to be devastated by construction traffic adding more tankers for something so fundamental creates further disruption and inconvenience to the local community. Adding a desalination plant to the already expansive development of Sizewell C at such a late stage beggars belief and further destroys this valuable, fragile habitat. This is another example of EDF thinking as they go along and making changes as they go, it shows once again EDF's disregard for the local area and proper consultation.

It truly concerns me that if they cannot get the fundamentals in place what hope do we have for a fully functioning nuclear power station.
