I am writing to urge you not to allow the development of Sizewell C on the following grounds:

It is neither a green nor renewable source of energy.

The cost of construction and decommissioning is prohibitive and the money could be far better used in other forms of energy production.

There is no guarantee that the plant can ever be made to operate as there is no working example of this type of reactor anywhere.

There is still considerable uncertainty about coastal defences and the effectiveness of the measures proposed.

There appears to be no solution to long term supply of water -
- apart from the very recent proposal for a desalination plant which brings a host of problems with it not least the environmental impact.

The construction of the plant will take an inordinate amount of time and will:
Devastate local rare habitats in the AONB.
Cause huge disruption with the vast amount of extra heavy goods traffic.
Have an enormously detrimental effect on local businesses and, critically, tourism which is a major part of the local economy.

In short the perceived benefits of this project are far outweighed by the drawbacks.

Again I urge you not to allow this development.
