I write to tell you that I am even less convinced of the merits of Sizewell C proposal now than I was 6 months ago. Then I had begun to think, like James Lovelock, that nuclear power was a good alternative to fossil fuels and that maybe the Suffolk coast was a good place to put a nuclear reactor of the proposed type. Since then, attending to the arguments from both sides I have become more and more convinced that it would be a disaster. There are so many serious concerns. Those which worry me and which are relevant to your powers include

- the lack of a long term water supply (this only emerged very recently)
- the deleterious effects of the proposed desalination plant
- worry about adequate coastal defences
- adverse impacts on biodiversity
- disruption and massively increased HGV and other traffic during the years of construction
- destruction of rare coastal habitats which the UK can ill afford to lose

Just imagine the relief if the proposal was finally rejected.

What a good feeling that would be - as well as an impetus to us all to find other, better solutions together.
