I object to this nuclear reactor as I think that it is in the wrong place (subject to future erosion from the sea especially) and much too costly. I am also not convinced that nuclear power generation is safe although there have been many safety improvements in recent years.

The need for us to generate more electricity: battery powered cars, cooking, keeping our homes warm etc is a given but this need can be offset to a greater or lesser extent with roof insulation in many domestic and commercial buildings, solar generated power and more efficient use of everyday appliances. There are still too many houses with little or no roof insulation so there is much that can be done to both help reduce global heating and to reduce the amount of land that is being concreted over as well as reducing the need for electricity.
