A note on the mental health disaster that will hit Woodbridge if you decide to run hourly trains throughout the night for a decade. It will decimate people's quality of life. The tracks run so close to so many houses, including sheltered accommodation/old people's homes.

You will be trapping people in their homes, unable to sell or move, and subject more disastrously to the grimly predictable torture of nightly ruined sleep and noise pollution for the next 12 years. This will affect literally thousands of people, and needs to be looked at very carefully for alternatives. Not to mention that trains of this length will cut certain areas off for vital minutes for emergency services who will be forced to stop and wait.

Please look at alternatives - using the sea, running extra train services during the day, or altering the train timetables so as not to put at risk the quality of life and mental health of the thousands of people who still seem oblivious to these almost inhumane proposals.
