Well they are numerous!

Cost of electricity produced is going to be far far higher than other renewables.

Risks. Very low but if they happen, the costs are enormous.

Benefits to the local community. Very poor. Disfigurement of the environment, specially during construction but also to lesser extent afterwards.

MY BIGGEST OBJECTION This proposed design is not functioning anywhere at October 2021.

As I understand it, the UK government basically underwrites the project. Thus we taxpayers pay twice, once for the high cost electricity and secondly we pay any increased taxes or cuts to welfare caused by our government having to bailout EDF.
