To Whom It May Concern,

I would like to voice my objection and concerns with regards to the proposed building of Sizewell C. I will mention just a few of the reasons why I am opposing this plan:

The Government seems to believe that Nuclear Energy is green; this is not the case; uranium is a depleting resource and nuclear waste will remain radioactive for 100,000 years - this is not a pleasant legacy to leave for our children. We need to have some forward thinking with regards to generating energy which means both developing and funding real green alternatives that do not impact our planet in a detrimental way.

Sizewell is on the edge of an area of AONB; the habitat loss caused by the building of another nuclear power station does not bear thinking about.
