Dear Inspectorate,

The Conclusions, section 5 of the Chatham House 2021 Report, make chilling reading. In relation to the site of the proposed Sizewell C development, I was recently privy to a conversation regarding 'Sea Defences' for the site.

It would appear that EDF have now publicly acknowledged that all their calculations and projections are based on the idea that the **Sandbanks** off the coast which presently offer 'protection' of the shoreline, **will remain stable throughout the life of the proposed site.**

This is obviously an absurd proposition as anyone with knowledge of coastal erosion and geology would concur.

I understand that EDF and yourselves are in possession of academic papers detailing this situation and I would urge that the findings are not dismissed or ignored.

I would also urge that the total Development of the Suffolk Sizewell C be advised to be declined, as the wrong technology in the wrong place at the wrong time.
