To Whom it May Concern,

I have e-mailed you before, more than once. I know I'm not alone in having done this, and certainly not alone in objecting to this scheme. I have been made aware that today is the final opportunity for objections to be raised.

My reasons for objecting, are as follows:

- This eroding coastline is not the place to build such a substantial plant, due to safety concerns.
- The negative impact on natural habitats are known to be devastating.
- The negative impact on local towns and villages is too significant to be remedied – road infrastructure is totally inadequate and inappropriate housing and community support for workers has been planned poorly.
- Environmental and UK energy benefits, regarding emissions and output, have not been provided with any transparency or coherency.
- The repeated concerns and objections raised by Suffolk residents have, it appears to me, been largely ignored and many legitimate questions remain unanswered.
- Costs.
