It's the wrong project, in the wrong place, at the wrong time.

- 1) The EPR design has proved to be deeply unreliable. EPR projects in Finland and France are a decade late, and are billions of Euros over budget. The only working model in the world, in China, has had to shut down.
- 2) The Suffolk coastline is entirely the wrong place for such a project. It would devastate local wildlife in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Placing Europe's largest construction site, working 24/7, right next to the RSPB reserve at Minsmere, would cause untold disturbance.
- 3) The Sizewell C site is on an eroding coastline, prone to flooding.
- 4) EdF have only recently admitted that there isn't an adequate supply of water for the construction.
- 5) By the time it's completed, nuclear technology will have been overtaken by renewables. It will be a white elephant before it starts operating.
- 6) The project would cause huge disruption to residents of East Suffolk, and their livelihoods. The tourist industry worth tens of millions of pounds to the local economy would be badly affected.
- 7) There is no clear plan as to how it will be paid for.
