The following are my major objections to the current proposals for Sizewell C:

- . The EPR reactor that EDF wants to build has an atrocious record. For example the EPR in China developed degraded fuel rod sealings and had to be closed after an international outcry. Do we want this to happen in Suffolk? NO!
- . Nuclear energy is not green energy. It's waste takes hundreds of years to degrade. Do we want future generations to pay for our mistakes? No!

Sizewell Marshes are an SSI and Minsmere RSPB reserve an internationally recognised project. As next door neighbours both are threatened by the current proposals for Sizewell C. Should we allow this to happen? No!
