I would like to register my opposition to the proposed development of Sizewell C. Decarbonising the UK power system by 2035 is critically important and the recent problems with rising fuel costs have demonstrated the need for the UK to find its own sustainable power sources. However, massive nuclear projects like Sizewell C are not the answer. It would not be carbon neutral, would be too slow, risky and expensive. It is also likely to be obsolete by the time it was completed. We need to be looking at a truly green home-grown strategy that would focus on renewables, energy storage, clean heat and energy efficiency. The building of a huge nuclear plant on the fragile Suffolk coast in an area of outstanding natural beauty will devastate the area and reduce even further the vital biodiversity of our countryside.

I urge you not to proceed with Sizewell C.
