Dear Dr Roast,

The Marine Management Organisation (“MMO”) received a request on 04 September 2023 to vary the Deemed Marine Licence (“DML”) contained within Schedule 21 of the Sizewell C (Nuclear Generating Station) Order 2022. The request was to make the following changes:

- An update of the Company name from ‘*NNB Generation Company (SZC)*’ to ‘*Sizewell C*’.
- An amendment to a typographical error in ‘Part 2- Licensed Activities (general), Section 4 (b) (ii)’, from ‘*2m wide*’ to ‘*62m wide*’.
- An amendment to a typographical error in ‘Part 2- Licensed Activities (general), Section 4 (c) (ii)’, from ‘*570.000m3*’ to ‘*570,000m3*’.
- An amendment to a typographical error in ‘Part 2- Licensed Activities (general), Section 4 (h) (ii)’, from ‘*Intake*’ to ‘*Outfall*’.
- A correction to Condition 45, Paragraph (3) which refers to the Fish Impingement and Entrainment Monitoring Plan (“*FIEMP*”), where it should refer to the Smelt Monitoring Plan (“*SMP*”).

The MMO has now completed its consideration of this request and, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 72(3)(d) of the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, has varied the DML as detailed in the Notice of Variation enclosed. Also enclosed is a copy of the varied DML.
