

**Proposed Development of a wind farm consisting of 27 wind turbines of up to 125m tip height and associated development**

**Land at Sweet Lamb Rally Complex, Y Foel, Powys**  
**Application by Mynydd y Gwynt Ltd**  
**Section 42 Planning Act 2008**

1. We are writing with regard to a proposed application to the Planning Inspectorate for a Development Consent Order to construct a wind farm on land at the Sweet Lamb Rally Complex, Y Foel, Powys.
2. The proposed development is described in more detail in the documents supplied with this letter but includes the construction of 27 wind turbines, each anticipated to be of 3MW generating capacity, and associated works.
3. Before the application is submitted to the Planning Inspectorate, Mynydd y Gwynt Ltd is required to formally consult with a number of prescribed organisations and bodies as set out under Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008. The responses to this consultation process will be taken into account by Mynydd y Gwynt Ltd in finalising the details of the proposed scheme before the application is submitted to the Planning Inspectorate.
4. You are a person or body with whom we are required to consult before submitting the application. Therefore, we now enclose the consultation documents produced by Mynydd y Gwynt Ltd:-
  - (i) A copy of the draft Non-Technical Summary relating to the proposed scheme.
  - (ii) A DVD containing the draft Environmental Statement relating to the scheme as currently proposed, together with the associated figures and appendices.
5. We shall be grateful to receive any comments that you may have on the details of the proposed scheme and the contents of the consultation documents as soon as possible.
6. In any event in accordance with the provisions of Section 42 of the 2008 Act we are required to provide a deadline by which any comments should be received.
