

**Points for the Mynydd y Gwynt PM
from Geoffrey Sinclair for the Cambrian Mountains Society**

1 Zone of Theoretical Visibility Maps

This is key information but the various maps only show the ZTV at 'tip-height'. There is no ZTV to refer to hub height, which is a normal and informative consideration.

ES ZTV Figure 5.1 shows Viewpoint Locations at an unreadably small scale but is the only Figure to do so. It can be viewed on screen at an enlarged scale, but not printed in that format. A common device is to have the main ZTVs available in four separate maps for NW, NE SW and SE quarters at a larger scale. Can this be done so as to show the information and the View Point locations at a readable printable scale, and with a variant for hub-height as well as tip-height?

2 Reproduction of Maps

Some maps are labelled '*For reference purposes only. No further copies may be made*'. Does this preclude information in the ES maps being printed out for use in responding to the proposal?

3 Dialogue with the Applicant's consultants
