I am writing to object to the proposed  
Mynydd y Gwynt Wind Farm, Y Foel,  
Llangurig. According to the IPC  
website this is listed as a project;  
up to 69 MW and a potential application  
date of 1/9/10. There is no information  
available on the Renewable Energy  
Holdings website and there would  
appear to have been no consultation.

The proposed site is very close to

Pumlumon and it will be an absolute travesty if the landscape of mid-Wales highest mountain is despoiled by wind turbines. This is a very popular walking area with the Wye Valley Way and Hafren Forest trails and a wind farm will completely spoil the peacefulness and tranquility.

I do not understand why developers are being allowed to make such proposals to the IPC but not to provide any public information when they register their proposal.

Please would you note my objections to the wind farm proposal.
