**The Dogger Bank Creyke Beck Offshore Wind Farm Order 2015 (as amended) (the 'DCO') – Non-material Change Application**

**Consultation and Publicity Statement under Regulation 7A of the Infrastructure Planning (Changes to, and Revocation of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011 ("the 2011 Regulations")**

The Parent Companies, SSE, Equinor and ENI of the Dogger Bank Creyke Beck Offshore Wind Farm Projects, herein 'the Project', have applied to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy, and Industrial Strategy for consent to make a non-material change (NMC) to the DCO (as amended) under section 153 and Schedule 6 of the Planning Act 2008. # DUO GIVEN PET BANS AFTER ABUSING DOG

**Two cousins have been banned from keeping dogs for a total of 25 years after they repeatedly slapped, punched and kicked a dog in front of shocked holiday-makers at a caravan park near Bridlington.**

Liam Tattershall and Luke

Harrison, both from Hull, were seen to attack the Staffordshire Bull Terrier dog called Patchy on multiple occasions in September 2020 at Skipsea Sands Caravan Park.

Three witnesses each saw the terrified pet being abused by the pair and reported the matter to the RSPCA, Beverley Magistrates' Court heard.

Tattershall pleaded guilty to causing unnecessary suf-

fering to Patchy and was given a 10-year ban on keeping dogs while Harrison was found guilty in his absence and received a 15-year ban.

One witness told how on Monday, September 21, as they arrived at the campsite, she saw Harrison punch Patchy - who was tethered - three times causing him to cower to the ground.

Later that day he was again

seen to approach the dog and hit him forcefully on its head three times, causing the dog to yelp on each occasion.

The following day the witness told how she saw Tattershall hit Patchy while he was tied up on the head twice.

He then kicked the dog with force in the ribs.

The dog was yelping each time he was hit.

On Wednesday the witness

saw shadows in the tent and could make out Harrison kicking the dog with force.

She could hear thuds and yelps and could see the shadow of his foot making contact with the dog while he was shouting at the pet. The witness confronted them and alerted security staff.

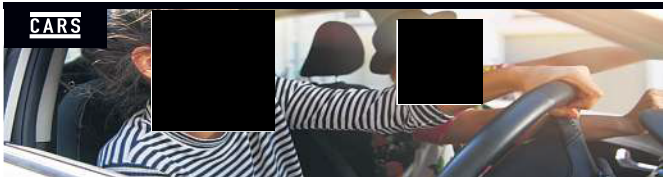

# HOSPITAL SERVICES FACING DISRUPTION

**People should expect disruptions to the normal operations of East Riding hospitals and other services as coronavirus case increases continue to affect staffing, the council's public health lead has said.**

East Riding of Yorkshire Coun-

cil's public health director Andy Kingdom said disruptions could last for a couple of weeks as infection surges lead to staff isolations and more patients come into hospital.

He added he was hoping that high vaccine booster uptakes would curb the amount of people needing hospital treatment but more time was needed to study the trends.

It comes as 6,385 new coronavirus cases were recorded in

the East Riding from Tuesday, December 28 to Monday, January 3, up from 3,364 cases in the previous week.

The rolling infection rate rose from 980 to 1,860 cases per 100,000 people during the same period.

Mr Kingdom said the increases were even larger among younger age groups, with the rate for working age adults rising from around 500 to about 2,500 per 100,000.

He added the rate for school age children had risen by between five and six times over the same period.

Mr Kingdom said: "We've seen a massive increase in infections.

"The question at the moment is do these new cases turn into hospitalisations or deaths?"

"I'm watching that very closely, because the hope is that having both vaccines and the booster will cut the likeli-

hood of that by around 85%. We know already that having vaccines reduces the chance people will end up in hospital, but the problem is it doesn't stop people passing coronavirus on to each other.

"That's got consequences which we're seeing with staffing not just in hospitals but in all the sectors which support them, that's the pressure that's

**The Dogger Bank Creyke Beck Offshore Wind Farm Order 2015 – proposed Non-material Change Application**

**Regulation 7(3) – Written consent from the Secretary of State for not consulting a person or authority**

Thank you for your letter of 28 October 2021 which sets out proposals for changes to the consented Dogger Bank Creyke Beck Offshore Wind Farm Order 2015 (“the 2015 Order”). The proposed changes refer to an increase in piling hammer energy for the pin piles (to be used on the offshore platforms) from 1,900 kilojoules (kJ) to 3,000 kJ; and, an increase in hammer energy for the monopiles from 3,000 kJ to 4,000 kJ. The letter requests the Secretary of State’s written consent under regulation 7(3) of the Infrastructure Planning (Changes to, and Revocation of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011 (as amended) (“the 2011 Regulations”) to a reduced and focused scope of consultation for the proposed Application from that carried out in respect of the acceptance of the application for the 2015 Order.

The Secretary of State has considered the request under regulation 7(3) of the 2011 Regulations. In Appendix 2 of your letter “Proposed list of stakeholders that wouldn’t be consulted on the non-material change application” the Secretary of State considers that there is insufficient justification provided by the Applicant to omit some of those organisations. The Secretary of State is of the view that where the reason given is “No response to previous non-material change application” or “NMC does not alter comments previously made” this does not in itself provide sufficient reason for excluding those persons or organisations from the current consultation. In particular, it is noted that at least one of those organisations has previously expressed concern regarding potential noise impacts. Therefore, the Secretary of State considers those stakeholders listed in Appendix

2 that he considers demonstrate insufficient justification should be consulted on the proposed non-material change application and therefore moved to Appendix 1 "Proposed list of stakeholders that would be consulted on the non-material change application". Please see Annex on page 3 below.

The Secretary of State agrees that those stakeholders that remain in Appendix 2 "Proposed list of stakeholders that wouldn't be consulted on the non-material change application" need not be consulted as they are not directly affected, either because the changes proposed will not affect their interests or because their interests relate to a different part of the scheme.

Accordingly, the Secretary of State gives written consent, to the extent set out above, under regulation 7(3) of the Infrastructure Planning (Changes to, and Revocation of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011.

In taking this decision the Secretary of State notes that while certain of those persons in the Appendix 2 List of Consultees will not be consulted directly in relation to the change proposals, there will also be public consultation in line with the requirements in regulation 20 of the 2011 Regulations.

Finally, the Secretary of State's written consent in this matter should not be taken as indicating approval for any other aspects of the proposed changes to The Dogger Bank Creyke Beck Offshore Wind Farm Order 2015 which fall to him for consideration and determination, or whether the proposed changes will ultimately be regarded as material or not.

We would like to confirm that a non-material change application to amend the Dogger Bank Creyke Beck Offshore Wind Farm Order 2015 has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS), alongside a parallel application to the Marine Management Organisation to amend the relevant Deemed Marine Licences.

The non-material change application is to amend the maximum energy that can be used by the pile hammer to install the pin-piles at the offshore platforms and the monopiles for the wind turbine generator foundations. This change is being sought to ensure that the piles can be successfully driven following refusal risk being identified through detailed pile driveability analysis. The changes being sought to the relevant parameters are as follows:

1. from 3,000 kilojoules to 4,000 kilojoules in the case of driven piles forming part of any wind turbine generator foundation structure; and
2. from 1,900 kilojoules to 3,000 kilojoules in the case of driven piles forming part of any offshore platform foundation structure.

This change does not necessitate amendments to any other project parameters and, as set out within the application documents, this amendment will comprise a “non-material” change as defined in the Planning Act 2008 and The Infrastructure Planning (Changes to, and Revocation of, Development Consent Orders) Regulations 2011 (as amended) (“the 2011 Regulations”).

You are being formally consulted by the Project on this change as you may have either previously expressed concern regarding potential noise impacts or responded to the previous non-material change application (which came into force 23 March 2020) which removed the maximum generating capacity of each project.
