

Application by Navitus Bay Development Ltd for the Navitus Bay Wind Park (the application)

Examining Authority's Record of Unaccompanied Inspection of Sites to Which the Application or Specified Matters Relates

Examining Inspectors Ava Wood, Peter Braithwaite, Jim Claydon and Stuart Cowperthwaite (the Panel appointed as the Examining Authority for the application for Navitus Bay Wind Park) undertook the inspections on 23, 24 July and 12, 13 and 14 August. Further site visits took place on 7 and 8 October and 15 and 16 October. This list updates the document published on 15 September 2014.

The inspections were undertaken by car and on foot on public roads and footpaths. A route was planned having regard to issues raised in relevant representations, enabling the Panel to obtain views of the proposed route of the underground cables that are part of the development associated with the offshore wind farm and views of the proposed offshore wind turbines from identified viewpoints.
