Subject: STOP Navitus Bay

Dear Ed Davey,

As the Secretary of State for Energy & Climate Change I beg that you change your mind and refuse planning permission for the construction the Navitus Bay Wind Farm.

They want to build up to 194 wind turbines 200m tall. The company has refused to provide me with information I have requested about the impact this development will have on our wonderful Dorset Coast.

They say that you have assessed them as likely to have "no significant impact" on the area but we are very likely to have the Jurassic Coast World Heritage Site Status taken away.

Demand they tell you the CARBON FOOTPRINT of building, running and decommissioning the wind park.

More energy could be saved by spending £3 billion to make some of the 25% of Bournemouth properties that are high energy consumers more efficient. Many are old properties with poor or no insulation. Many people living in them are poor and on low incomes.

Saving energy is far better than generating energy and it would reduce FUEL POVERTY.

Rather than subsidise a French and Dutch Company why not pay Feed in Tariffs for home owners to provided energy using solar power or heat pumps.

Of course I will never vote Lib Dem again if you champion this monstrosity of a project.

Hoping that one of my points makes you think about rejecting Navitus Bay.
