FURTHER INFORMATION

On 21 November 2012 East Anglia ONE Limited (**the Applicant**) of 4th Floor, 1 Atlantic Quay, Glasgow G2 8JB applied to the Secretary of State for Energy and Climate Change for a development consent order (**DCO**) under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the **Application**). The Application was accepted for examination on 14 December 2012 (Reference: EN010025).

The Application relates to the construction and operation of an offshore wind farm within the East Anglia zone of the North Sea (the **Project**). The proposed wind farm is 43.4 km from the coast of Suffolk at its closest point to land and will connect to the National Grid via underground cables to the new converter station at Bramford, Suffolk.

The DCO would, amongst other things, authorise:

- 1 Up to 325 offshore wind turbines, with a maximum height of 200m, to provide an installed electrical capacity of up to 1200 MW.
- 2 Up to three offshore collector stations and up to two offshore converter stations.
- 3 Up to one offshore meteorological mast to collect information such as wind speeds and wind direction.
- 4 Undersea cables to link the wind turbines, the offshore stations and meteorological mast.
- 5 Up to four offshore undersea export cables to transmit electricity from the offshore stations to the shore.
- 6 A landfall site at Bawdsey with onshore transition pits to connect the offshore and onshore cables.
- 7 Up to four onshore underground cables, with jointing pits, running for approximately 37 km from the landfall at Bawdsey to the connection point near Bramford, Suffolk, to transmit electricity to a new onshore converter station and up to eight additional underground cable ducts to accommodate the cables for future projects.
- 8 An onshore converter station adjacent to existing National Grid infrastructure near Bramford, Suffolk, to connect the offshore wind farm to the National Grid.
- 9 The permanent and/or temporary compulsory acquisition of land and/or rights for the Project.
- 10 Overriding of easements and other rights over or affecting land for the Project.
- 11 The application and/or disapplication of legislation relevant to the Project including inter alia legislation relating to compulsory purchase.
- 12 Such ancillary, incidental and consequential provisions, permits or consents as are necessary and/or convenient.

The proposed works are environmental impact assessment (**EIA**) development for the purposes of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2009 and accordingly an Environmental Statement accompanied the Application. Further to the request under Rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 from the Planning Inspectorate dated 9 September 2013, the Applicant has prepared further information for the Project.
