Background to the DCO and DML Hearing Agenda

The Agenda for this hearing is not detailed. Following the last hearings relating to the DCO and DMLs on 6 -7 November 2013, parties were given extra time to respond to actions and provide representations. These responses are due at Deadline IX which is 28 November 2013. It is also advised that the applicant is submitting a revised DCO on this date.

It is the Examining Authority's (ExA) intention to examine the revised DCO and DMLs methodically to identify any revisions and any matters not agreed between the applicant and interested parties.

The ExA requests that all parties ensure that they have read and bring with them the representations made in response to Deadline IX (12pm 28 November 2013).

It should also be noted that this agenda will consider any matters outstanding following the s127 and Compulsory Acquisition hearings scheduled for the 27-28 November 2013 where they may have implications for the wording of the proposed draft Development Consent Order. Affected parties may therefore wish to attend if they have not reached agreement with the applicant regarding any property interest proposed for compulsory acquisition by 5-6 December 2013.
