In the light of the content of the written submissions received from the interested parties to date, I have decided to request that the relevant named parties provide further information in response to the questions, which are put under Rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010.

Responses should be submitted by **Wednesday 7 October 2015**.

Request for further information

1. Noise

The following questions are directed to **the Applicant** and **Selby District Council (SDC)**, regarding the position on Requirement 23, Appendix 1 to the Statement of Common Ground between the applicant, North Yorkshire County Council (NYCC) and SDC.

- 1.1 SDC, the Table shows a night-time figure of 40dB (WHO recommendation) which is higher than the SDC recommendation. Can SDC explain why 40dB is too high in this case?
- 1.2 Applicant, the Table shows a daytime noise rating level at Receptor 5 as being Background +10dB. Why is this higher than SDC's recommendation of +5dB?

- 1.3 Applicant, R23(3). Can the Applicant provide further justification why the subsection suggested by SDC (new subsection f) should not be included in the Requirement?

The following question is directed to **Selby District Council**

- 2.1 SDC, Provide comments on the material in the Summary of Noise Mitigation Measures, submitted by the Applicant for Deadline VII.
