I am responding on behalf of Doncaster Metropolitan Borough Council (DMBC) to your letter dated 24th November 2014 regarding the above.

Having had regard to Sections 42, 47 and 48 of the 2008 Planning Act I am of the view that Capture Power Ltd. has carried out adequate pre-application consultation in accordance with the provisions set out in Sections 42, 47 and 48 of the Act.

Capture Power Ltd. commenced early engagement with DMBC early during March 2012 where initial contact was made with the Council in order to discuss the parameters of the project and the scope of the environmental information that would need to be considered in any future application. It was evident that there would be very little impact in relation to Doncaster MBC as a result of the distances involved. This was related to Capture Power Ltd.

In conclusion having read the Capture Power Ltd. consultation document, which has been submitted to the Planning Inspectorate, I am satisfied that they have undertaken extensive and inclusive consultation in support of the proposal. In this respect DMBC considers the applicant's consultation to be adequate and in line with Section 42, 47 and 48 of the 2008 Planning Act.
